

It is difficult for me to have a relationship without distrust and anger toward my partner and now husband. Bonding with my child was very difficult. I had severe post-partum depression and avoidance of babies.

Even 13 years later, I am filled with sadness when I think of that day. I wish someone had spoken with me about the sense of loss and depression that can follow abortion. I have friends that have had abortions and they cry and tell me that they try to block the experience out of their minds because it is so painful to recall. I understand their pain. Even though having an abortion was my decision, I feel that I was a victim in a

lot of ways. I told myself at the time, that an abortion was okay because it was legal. If abortion had not been legal, I would of had my child and I would have loved her. I was scared when I became pregnant and abortion seemed the easy answer. Believe me it is not easy. I have emotional pain that will last a lifetime due to this decision. Please stop abortion and stop victimizing women and children in the name of choice. By supposedly empowering women with a choice, you are sending us to a painful life of regret and sadness.

10. How has your abortion affected others in your life?

The depression/anger issues that I have suffered due to my abortion have affected my husband, children and other loved ones in my life. For many years, I was not able to be the kind of wife/mother to my family that I should have been. The pain/guilt of my past overwhelmed me to the point to where I could not love them or care for them as they desired me to.

It seems like such an easy option. I thought that I could just go and have an abortion and forget that I was ever pregnant. Instead, after the abortion I was depressed/angry and hardly able to function for awhile. I kept wondering why no one told me that I would feel such a sense of loss and pain. I grieved for the child that I had made a choice to kill. Please don't let fear lead you to do something that you will regret for the rest of your life. I felt dead inside after my abortion. In a way my abortion killed 2 people- my child died and I felt dead emotionally. I pray that this doesn't happen to you. There are other options- raising the baby yourself or adoption. I didn't want anyone to know that I had become pregnant and I didn't feel that the timing was right for me to raise a child. I was alone and afraid. However, any pain I would have experienced from others knowing that I was pregnant would have been so minor compared to the pain I have experienced from having an abortion. I miss the child that I never got to know. It is an awful awful feeling.

Under the false pretense of empowering womwn with a choice, abortion is victimizing numerous women such as myself. I have lived with depression, grief and suicidal thoughts since my abortion 14 years ago. Please stop allowing the killing of children and the victimizing of women.

I lost one marriage following the ectopic pregnancy that nearly killed me...I had so much pain in those days. I live daily with the reminder that I can never change what I did, I look at young adults who would be the age of my aborted child, wondering what he/she would have looked like, how much I would love to know him/her; how good a parent I would be now that I have dealt with the pain, knowing that will never happen; telling my children about the choice I made to deny them a sibling that they will never know. The ramifications continue, even though my life is healthy overall. I wish I had known that that one choice would alter the course of my life forever, it was not just one simple act.

I broke the hearts of my parents by all of the behaviors that had not existed prior to the abortion. I have never been able to tell my parents about the abortion, it would kill them.



- 4) Did anyone pressure you into having an abortion? Yes If so, who? The abortion clinic by way of not helping me, forced me to go through the abortion. After the laminar sticks were inserted, I left for the day and was told to return the next day for the abortion. That evening I called the hotline and told the attendant that I had changed my mind and wanted to keep my baby. They told me that I couldn't change my mind and that my baby was already dead. I believed they lied. They should have helped me save my baby.
- 5) How has your abortion affected you? Physically it injured my cervix. It would not dilate even after pitocin and prostaglandin was used. I've had 3 c-sections. Emotionally, it sucked the life from me. All of my future plans were lost, not because of a pregnancy anymore but because of the lack of zeal for life. One of the reasons why I got an abortion was to save my basketball scholarship but after finishing one season I quit the sport. The next fall I dropped out of college completely. I fought nightmares of having my children die while I stood helplessly by trying to save them but couldn't. I desperately tried to get married to anyone so I could have a baby and try to undo the horrible thing I had done.
- 6) How has your abortion affected others in your life? My parents were deeply grieved by my choice. It put a great strain our relationship. They mourn for their lost grandchild and were tormented with anger. My husband had to pay higher medical costs for the C-sections of our children. He must also pay for the additional breast exams due to my increased risk of breast cancer.
- 7) Based on your own experiences, what would you tell a woman considering an abortion? Abortion will not make her crisis pregnancy go away. The physical and emotional side effects of abortion last a lifetime. If you do not want to parent your child please consider adoption. Although giving your child away may seem very painful it is never as painful as killing your child. A pregnancy will change your life no matter what option you chose to deal with it: parenting, abortion or adoption. All three choices will remain with you but only abortion leaves you with sadness, regret, and painful side effects. It kills your baby and leaves you injured for life.
- 8) Based on your own experience, what would you tell a court that believes abortion should be legal? Abortion is not a simple solution. It is fatal to our children and very harmful to our women. We have other options that are viable that do not leave life long scarring.
